SCHEDULE OF VOLUNTARY SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2024

Dear Parents/Caregivers

Financial support provided by families through voluntary contributions and charges plays a critical role in maintaining quality teaching and learning programs and enabling the provision of an enriched curriculum and enhanced learning experiences for students.

Parents, who contribute financially to the school through the voluntary contributions, assist in the maintenance of educational resources at a level needed to meet children's needs in a constantly changing educational environment. Key areas such as literacy, numeracy, science and information technology are enhanced through the voluntary contributions.

Swanbourne Primary School Board has endorsed the following schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2024 which will enable families to budget for all expenses throughout 2024. We hope all families see the importance of paying the contribution and supporting our student learning programs in 2024.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of voluntary contributions is in accordance with the School Education Regulations 2000. The School Voluntary Contribution for 2024 is \$60.00 per child, and the P&C Voluntary Contribution for 2024 is \$120.00 per child.

Payments can be made to your child's account at any time throughout the year to remain in credit. A reminder of unpaid billed items will be sent home twice per term for the finalisation of any outstanding payments. ADDITIONAL GENERAL EDUCATIONAL CHARGES

The charges schedule includes:

- Specific learning activities which are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made. (E.g. incursions, excursions, recreational activities, etc.)
- Specific learning activities which are available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made. (e.g. school camps, PEAC, Instrumental Music)
- Other activities which are available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made.
 (e.g. graduation activities)
